1. Cigarette Butts

- Possible Judges: Freelance Star editor, 2 downtown merchants

- if schools give ok, need Carl to design flyer to solicit prize money from merchants and individual donors

using "Keep It Neat To The Streets" theme

- Target advertisement for Nov. 15, America Recycles Day

- can use press release to bring attention to issue

- if we solicit Phillip Morris for monies, receptacles, pocket ashtrays, etc. they will require measurable

statistics which entails much more work than we have volunteers or time

- media possibilities: Channel 24 (need to check with Cox), Fredericksburg Film Festival, Keep America Beautiful
