Call to Order at 8:10am

Tree Committee Update

Tree Pruning workshop for City staff on March 2nd at UMW was a great success. We had over 45 attendees including staff from Parks and Rec, Public Works, Master gardeners, UMW staff. Guy Mussey from extension gave the class along with Rob Allen from Bartlett Trees. Clean & Green Commission, Public Works, Tree Fredericksburg and UMW staff sponsored the workshop. We were very fortunate to have such great participation and volunteer help. An additional class will be held in the fall for those unable to attend this time.

Matthew Boltz the arborist for Dominion Power made a presentation to our committee. Matt will be joining our committee and we are looking for other ways to partner with Dominion to plant the right trees under power lines and for possible financial assistance.

The Washington Mall Arbor Day event on April 16th will be held at 10am. The entire commission is invited.

The Tree canopy study with the State Forestry Dept is in the process. Dave King from Public Works is working on this with Barbara White from the State.. The Commission will work with Public Works on this project.

The Commission is connecting with Downtown merchants and residence to communicate our efforts for improving the downtown area. In conjunction with Economic Development and Public Works, we will be working on removing bad trees; planting new trees; re-orienting tree wells to not obstruct car doors; enlarging tree wells to give the roots more room; installing recycle bins on Caroline Street; and working with downtown of flowers and plantings in the tree wells and flower pots.

We will be working with public Works to check the contract for the phone company contract for tree pruning and try to connect with their forestry dept.
