




## Welcome to Motts Run

## Rules and Regulations

- No wading or swimming
- No camping
- No alcohol
- No motorized vehicles or bikes offroad
- No hunting
- No disturbance or removal of plant or animal life
- All dogs must be on leash
- No metal detectors

**Boating Regulations**

- No gas motors allowed on lake (electric only)
- Must be 18 to rent or launch boat
- No animals allowed in boats
- Children 16 and under must wear lifevest
- Boats must be brought in 30 minutes prior to park closing (3 blasts of airhorn will signal time)
- Persons renting equipment are liable for damage or loss

**Fishing Regulations**

- All fishermen MUST CHECK IN & OUT
  - Submit ALL FISH for inspection
  - State fishing license required
  - Bank fishing in designated areas only
  - 16 & under, disabled, active-duty military fish free
  - Children 12 & under must fish with adult
- FISH LIMITS:**
- Large Mouth Bass - NO Min. length, 5/day
  - Northern Pike - Min. length 20", 2/day limit
  - Walleye - 8/day
