PARTNER AGENCIES

The FY 2022 Adopted Budget recommends \$2,685,991 to community nonprofit organizations and regional governmental and quasi-governmental organizations serving the region. These amounts do not include transfers to the Rappahannock Regional Jail or the Juvenile Detention Center, which are presented separately in their own budget narrative.

In FY 2022 the City recommends restoring some of the reductions made to community organizations in FY 2021, notably for the Rescue Squad (\$200,000, up from \$100,000 in FY 2021).

All other community partners are recommended at level funding from FY 2021. The Fredericksburg Area Museum was funded at \$85,000 in FY 2021 due to the pandemic, and a separate appropriation related to the relocation of the slave auction block was made later in FY 2021 that brought the annual total appropriation to \$100,000. The recommendation of \$85,000 is intended to reflect level funding for operations.

Funding for the United Way and for the Virginia Tech Master Gardeners program was discontinued in FY 2021 due to fiscal uncertainty resulting from the pandemic. Some funds are restored to these organizations in the recommended budget at the discretion of Council.

ABOUT PARTNER AGENCIES

The City of Fredericksburg provides funding for certain community-based nonprofit organizations as well as governmental and quasi-governmental regional organizations providing services to City and other jurisdictions in the region.

Community-based nonprofit organizations supported by the City either provide health & human services to City residents; or focus on arts, education, environment, or cultural resources.

The City participates in several regional partnerships with surrounding jurisdictions. Details of those partnerships are disclosed in this section.
