KINDER MORGAN/PRODUCTS (SE) PIPELINE MAINTENANCE PROJECT

- **Who will be managing this project?**

This project is being completed by Kinder Morgan, owner of the Products (SE) Pipeline. They will be responsible for completing all work associated with the project. The City's Public Works Department will be monitoring the project to ensure safe practices, proper traffic maintenance, and compliance with City regulations.

- **What is the nature of this project?**

The contractor will be performing two (2) maintenance work/anomaly digs on the existing 12" pipeline located in the City right-of-way. Due to the locations of excavation, traffic lane closures and/or pedestrian detours may be required.

- **When will the work take place?**

The first dig will begin on or about May 23, 2022, and work will be completed on or about June 6, 2022. There may be additional digs to follow in the coming months. Should this be the case, you will receive additional notice of that work prior to its commencement.

- **Where will the work occur?**

The work will take place on Frazier Street and on Howard Avenue (near the intersection of Airport Avenue), in the City of Fredericksburg. A map of the two project sites is enclosed.

- **Why is this work necessary?**

The work is required because Kinder Morgan has detected pipe anomalies on their 12" pipeline. The Pipeline and Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) has deemed it necessary to investigate and repair these anomalies.

- **How will this work be completed?**

The roadways will be cut and excavated in order to expose the sections of pipeline where the anomalies have been detected. Trench boxes will be used in order to minimize the damage to the streets and to ensure the size and safety of the excavation sites. City Inspectors will monitor the excavation and the maintenance of pedestrian and vehicular traffic to ensure proper procedures are followed and resident access is maintained. A map identifying road closures and detours is enclosed.
